Buckle up for a panoramic, fast moving and fantastical ride, as Voltaire's classic satire of enlightment insanity *Candide*, is let looses as a gigantic folly in the world premiere theatrical adaptation of *Optimism*.

Melbourne's favourite modern clown, **Frank Woodley**, is our hero, the criminally cheerful *Candide* who travels with unbridled enthusiasm from Edenic paradise to painful disillusionment with a round-the-world adventure reminiscent from the best adventure and romance tales! In a quest to return to his childhood love, Cunegode, *Candide* meets compounding tragedies with comedy and an ever optimistic outlook, until experience teaches him to reject optimism in a search to question 'Is this the best of possible world's.'.....

Director Michael Kantor (*Woyzeck, Through the Looking Glass*) and writer Tom Wright (*The Odyssey, The Women of Troy*) present Voltaire's picaresque novel exploded for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century, in a world informed by the threats of climate change, third world exploitation, rampaging consumerist waste, the threat of theologically-inspired terrorism and begging the question of how to believe in a benevolent God when experience tells you otherwise?

Cunningly they dissect a sacred cow of contemporary Australia – the myth of positive thinking in a world gone horribly wrong.

Live music performed by Iain Grandage (*Vamp*) and a suitably optimistic design from Anna Tregloan and Paul Jackson thrust Candide into a broad, red-faced burlesque world which is a keen dissection of the foibles of human longing. Frank Woodley is joined on stage by a cast of consummate character actors including Caroline Craig (*Underbelly*), Alison Whyte (*Tartuffe, Don's Party*), Amber McMahon (*The War of the Roses*), Francis Greenslade (*Babes in the Woods*), Hamish Michael (*Woyzeck*) and David Woods (*Exit the King*).

Religious blasphemy, political sedition and an insightful portrayal of the human condition has thrust Voltaire's Candide into great success and great scandal. Reeking with scurrilous vice, this new adaption of *Optimism* transforms Voltaire's classic satire of enlightened insanity into a cutting commentary on the no-worries bravura of the Australian swagger.
